

RACE DIRECTOR CHECKLIST – BEGINNERS

- New rider must attend extra safety meeting after riders meeting with Race Director.
- HAVE RIDERS COMPLETED NEW RACER CHECKLIST.**
- Race director to reiterate all safety items discussed at the normal riders meeting.
- Race director to confirm new riders understanding of all flags. Ensure they know to put their hand up when stopping/slowing down.
- New rider to start on outside of grid and wear high visibility vest
- New rider is not at any time allowed to cut in tight to first turn buoy-must hold their line.
- New rider is to be aware of boats approaching at every buoy and pmust check both inside and outside for other racers.
- New rider must always be aware of safety marshal's and continually check for signals from marshals.
- If new rider places themselves or other racers in danger they must follow directions of race director.
- Race director to watch for dangerous riding techniques and has the authority to allow or disallow a rider to continue racing at a particular event at his/her discretion.
- New rider is not allowed to race a competitor to a buoy if the proximity endangers either rider and there is a possibility of a collision.
- New rider must show they have the skills required to operate their race craft adequately in racing conditions otherwise the new rider will be refused to participate without refund.
- If any of the above guidelines are not adhered to the rider will be refused to continue and refused refund.
- New rider recommended to use effective sponsosns.
- No launch control recommended. Middle finger under throttle suggested.
